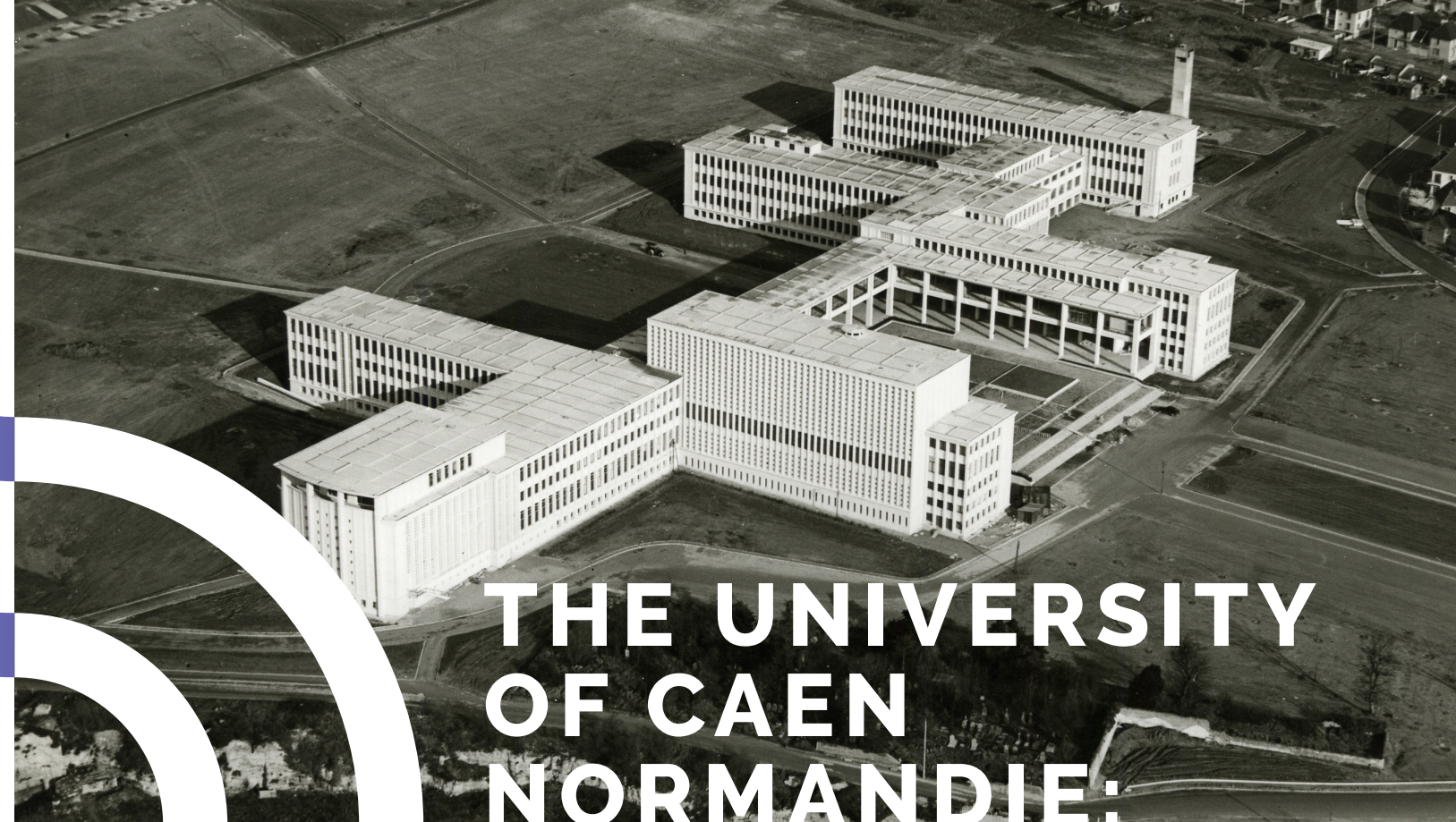

## THE UNIVERSITY OF CAEN NORMANDIE: 600 YEARS OF EXPERTISE

**SIX CENTURIES OF HISTORY,  
A PRESTIGIOUS HERITAGE  
THAT COMPELS  
AND INSPIRES**

Founded in 1432 by John of Lancaster, 1st Duke of Bedford and Regent of France, during a period when Normandy was under English rule, the University of Caen Normandie was initially established to educate the English elite governing the French territories. At the time, it was the third English university to be founded, after Oxford and Cambridge. The Hundred Years' War, the Wars of Religion, and the French Revolution nearly caused its demise. Completely destroyed in July 1944, the university, like Normandy, paid a heavy price for the victory over Nazism.

Louis Leygue's sculpture at the entrance to the Caen campus depicts a phoenix, symbolising the rebirth brought about with the help of the international community after the Second World War. Campus 1, rebuilt by architect Henri Bernard, is now a listed building.

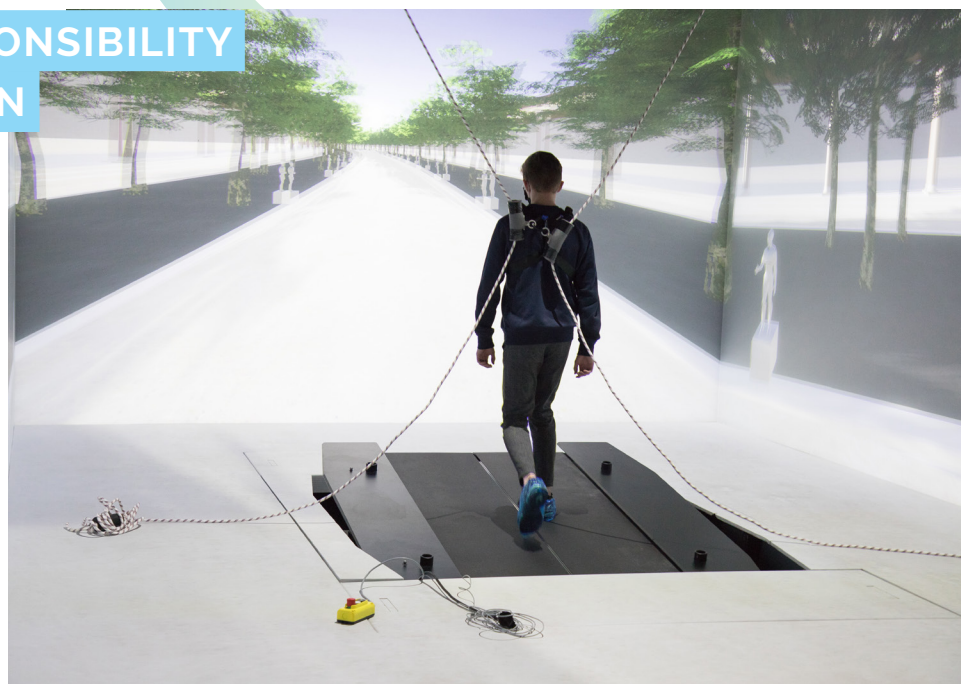
The Fondation 1432 is active in several key areas:

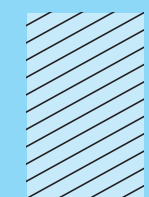

## INDIVIDUALS

For income tax purposes, the donation is deductible up to 66%, with a limit of 20% of taxable income. For wealth tax purposes, 75% of the donation can be deducted, up to a limit of €50,000.
